

Agriculture Homeland Security Communications

The Homeland Security Information Network, or HSIN, is an encrypted and unclassified web-based system to serve information sharing needs between partner groups. The web-portal strategy is setup with multiple compartments to separate data for security and can manage information for critical infrastructure sectors (e.g. Agriculture) by sub-sector (e.g. animal, plant, food, cultural resource).

Agricultural and Natural Resources stakeholders across Georgia form a community of interest (COI) that interacts through state agencies, GEMA All Hazards Councils and informally through other means. The HSIN Georgia site is part of the DHS web-based portal network. HSIN has an established portal for information relevant to Georgia Agriculture. Vetted participants can post documents, maintain discussions, schedule collaboration on the interactive calendar, and maintain email alerts for announcing new postings or events.
